The Hobart Human Library has been created to address discrimination and bullying through the power of personal storytelling.

Aligned with A Fairer World, a social justice global learning centre for 30 years, the library was set up in 2013.

The library works with human "books" who tell their story to a group of "readers". It is used in schools as a way of learning and developing empathy and understanding between people with different backgrounds. These differences may be race, religion, brain injury, sex change or "differently abled". The students can see stereotypes and prejudices fall away. The human library can be used in schools, for conferences and in workplaces.
