Last Week: the Mousally family from Syria



We heard a very moving story from Jean, the youngest son of Yousef and Rania. He told of their life in Aleppo before the war began and their struggles during the conflict, their flight from Syria, to eventually arrive in Hobart in November last year. We saw fabulous pictures of the beauty of Aleppo before the war, (one of the oldest continuously inhabited cities in the world, and a UNESCO site of archaeological significance) and learned of the Syrian life of free education, free health care and full employment in their enormous manufacturing industries.

"It was a hard decision but in the end you have to make it. You can live without electricity, you can live without water, but in the end you are facing [death] every day so you have to make this decision," (Yousef Mousally)
There are now 6 million internally displaced Syrians and more than 4 million refugees.
