Child Health And Parenting Service
100 years In Tasmania



Melissa is a midwife and Child health nurse, as well as a busy mother of four. We learnt from her the many roles that make up the valuable CHAPS service provided to all mothers in Tasmania. From weighing babies, hearing and vision testing, health and growth assessments, developmental milestones, feeding and nutrition advice and dental health, to parenting advice and mental health care for families with children from birth to starting school. There is also the role of data gathering for studies such as the La Trobe University study into communication and Autism. These are the front line carers for identifying children with needs that may need referrals to e.g. St Giles for physio or speech support. They run a very valuable See you at Home program for teenage mothers and other at home visiting for families at risk.

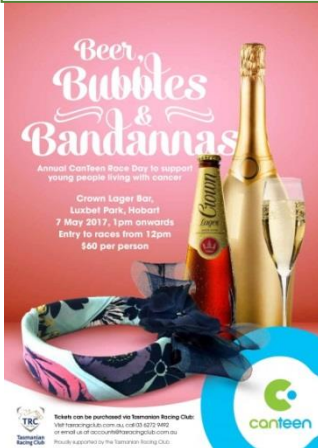
