

Rotary Club of Salamanca Achievement Scholarships

College Scholarships

The College Scholarships be comprised of two \$1 000 scholarships, one per college (Elizabeth College and Hobart College), on an annual basis.

The scholarships be awarded to a year 12 student:

- from either an Indigenous, migrant or refugee background.
- who will be undertaking a university or TAFE recognised course of study in the following year.
- who has attained high levels of academic excellence.
- who has a passion for learning and self-development.
- who demonstrates a strong commitment to community.
- who is recognised by the College as coming from a family with limited financial resources.

The scholarship would be a `one-off` payment to provide a `kick-start` for tertiary study, covering such costs as:

- course and tuition fees,
- books and equipment and
- other incidental costs.

The \$1 000 scholarship be paid subject to negotiation between the College and the nominated students after their enrolment in a tertiary institution is confirmed to the Rotary Club of Salamanca.

The scholarship be referred to as the 'Rotary Club of Salamanca Achievement Scholarship'.

A Salamanca Club representative be invited to present the scholarships at the respective college award ceremony.

Primary School Scholarships

The Scholarships will comprise two awards of \$250 to be awarded to two students in grade 6 at Clarendon Vale Primary School in December of each year.

The awards are to be made in recognition of student high achievement across a range of areas, along with a strong commitment to:

- learning,
- community,
- Self-development and
- continuing education at the secondary level.

The money be directed towards the respective receiving secondary schools to cover education expenses of the recipients such as:

- textbooks,
- levies,
- equipment,
- online costs,
- uniforms and any other incidental expenses associated with secondary school enrolment.

Each student receive an appropriately framed certificate at the end of year presentation assembly entitled 'Rotary Club of Salamanca Student Achievement Bursary'.

A representative of the Rotary Club of Salamanca be invited to present the awards to the students at the assembly.

Each recipient to be invited to attend a Rotary Meeting by the club representative.
