Informal Club Forum



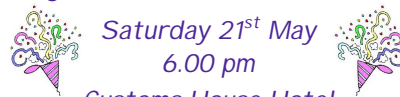
In the absence of the scheduled speaker we had a chance to catch up after the Easter break and for an informal club forum, beginning a discussion of club projects, which will be continued next week.

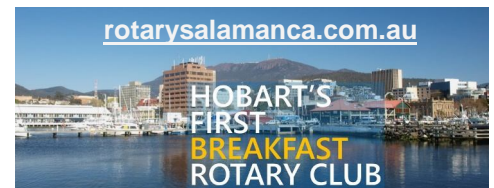
