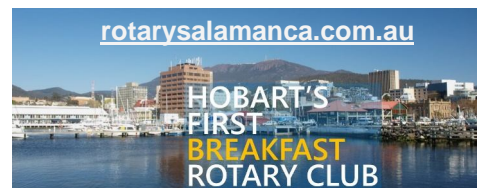
Pam Scott gave an update on ShelterBox's work providing emergency shelter for families in areas of natural disaster and also in conflict zones, including Ukraine.
