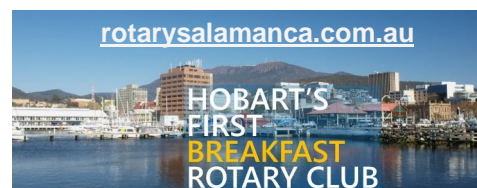


President Alex & Board members summarised items from the recent Board meeting, including:
