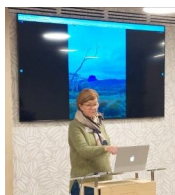
### LAST WEEK

#### Overland Track Return



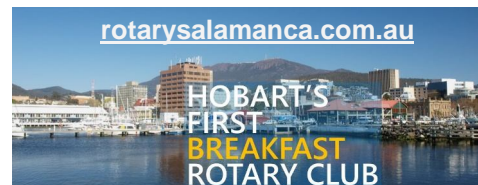
Chrissy and Scott have returned safely from an enjoyable walk on the Overland Track.
